



2018 GO by BIKE Mini-Grant program recipients

- **BikeSD Outreach** will host a bike-in movie event at Jefferson Elementary on Friday, May 18 at 6 p.m. The event will feature a pre-movie bike safety presentation by a local bike shop, and giveaways including bike light sets and a children's bike.
- **Circulate San Diego** will transform parking space in the Logan Heights Community to stage a parklet and host a bike clinic on Saturday, April 14. They will partner with a local bike shop to provide bike tune-ups in preparation for Bike to Work Day and educate community members on the benefits of riding a bike.
- **City Heights Community Development Corporation** will lead an educational bike tour in the Mid-City area on Saturday, June 16 to inform community members and bike commuters of new and planned bikeways, and provide participants with refreshments along the way.
- **City of Chula Vista** will host South Bay Earth Day on Saturday, April 7 from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. at Chula Vista Marina featuring a guided tour of Bayshore Bikeway, a bike rodeo, bike valet, and raffle prizes. They also will host a bike scavenger hunt on May 2 at City Hall at 11:30 a.m.
- **City of Coronado** will host an outdoor bike-in movie event on Friday, May 18 at Tidelands Park. Pre-movie activities start at 6:30 p.m., including a bike rodeo, mechanic, and prizes for attendees who GO by BIKE to the event. A screening of 'The Wizard of Oz' will start at 8 p.m.
- **City of Oceanside** will encourage residents to participate in Bike to Work Day at Oceanside farmer's markets on April 26, May 3, and May 10. People who register for Bike to Work Day will be provided with a free water bottle. Additionally, they will host two free bike safety seminars on May 13 and May 16 from 12 – 1 p.m. at the Oceanside Public Library.
- **County of San Diego Department of Parks and Recreation** will host a community night bike ride in Lakeside at Lindo Lake Park on Saturday, May 19 from 6 – 8 p.m. The Sheriff's Department and San Diego County Bicycle Coalition will provide information on bike safety, and participating children can win raffle prizes including bikes and safety equipment.

- **Diamond Business Association** will educate residents and businesses about local bike projects, and encourage riders and drivers to share the road by creating t-shirts, bags, and street banners that will be displayed along key business corridors in the Chollas View community.
- **Family Health Centers of San Diego, Inc.** will educate community members about bike safety and the benefits of biking at the Barrio Logan Grand Prix on Saturday, April 28 from 9 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. Activities include face painting, games, and music, and attendees will have the opportunity to enter a raffle to win one of 100+ children's bike helmets.
- **San Diego Public Library, Pacific Beach Branch** will host a 'Bike-in Movie for Eco-Heroes' on the Taylor Greene in Pacific Beach on Friday, May 4. Pre-movie activities from 6 – 8 p.m. will consist of bike maintenance checks, bike safety presentations, and giveaways including bike locks and bike lights, before a screening of 'Coco' at 8:15 p.m.
- **San Diego State University (SDSU) School of Public Affairs** will host a Bike to Campus day at SDSU on Tuesday, April 10 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m., featuring a campus bike fair to provide participants with information about bike maintenance and safety in preparation for Bike to Work Day.
- **San Diego County Bicycle Coalition** will host a Bike Month kickoff celebration in Downtown San Diego on Thursday, May 3 from 6 – 9 p.m. The family-friendly event will feature a community bike ride, local bike vendors, a live band, food, and giveaways.
- **The Urban Collaborative Project** will host a Bike to Art festival on Saturday, May 26 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. in Chicano Park featuring a bike exhibition, bike safety rodeo, bike repair, and live art painting.
- **University Heights Community Association (UHCA)** will host a bike-in movie at Trolley Barn Park on Friday, May 19 at 7:30 p.m. Participants are encouraged to bike to the movie, walk the red carpet, and enjoy a free bike valet, popcorn, and a raffle.
