



2020 GO by BIKE Mini-Grant program recipients

- **Bikes del Pueblo** will lead a community bike ride ending at Digital Gym Cinema in North Park for a screening of “The Motherload”—a film about a car-free family.
- **BikeSD Outreach** will host a workshop about bike riding with pets, followed by a ride near Nate’s Point Dog Park in Balboa Park.
- **BikeWalkSolana** will host a bike-in movie night and cargo-bike demonstration at Revolution Bike Shop in Solana Beach.
- **Circulate San Diego** will install temporary wayfinding signs to guide and encourage bike riders through Downtown San Diego from March 14-June 14 before permanent signs are installed.
- **City Heights Community Development Corporation** will celebrate 30 years of Bike to Work Day with a “Ride Through 1990’s Mid-City” community bike ride in the City Heights community.
- **City of Chula Vista** will host two events on South Bay Earth Day, Saturday, April 4: a guided bike ride on the Bayshore Bikeway and a bike safety rodeo for kids. They also will host a Lunch and Learn about bike safety on Thursday, April 30 and a ride on the expanded Broadway Bikeway on Saturday, May 16.
- **City of Coronado** will share Coronado’s unique bike culture through the production and premiere of a short film at the Coronado Promenade Concerts.
- **City of Encinitas** will host a bike-in movie at Glen Park on Saturday, May 9, complete with a bike giveaway and other prizes.
- **City of La Mesa** will host a kid-centered, superhero-themed bike safety rodeo on Saturday, March 21 from 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. at Grossmont Center, and a “Pedal for the Planet” trail ride on Saturday, April 18 from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the La Mesa Earth Day Festival.
- **City of San Diego** will lead a bike ride from Downtown to Barrio Logan ending with a bike safety lunch and learn, complete with free lunch and limited rental bikes.

- **Clairemont Town Council Foundation** will offer a kid's bike safety rodeo on Saturday, May 23 and a Clairemont Canyons community bike ride to bring awareness to new trails.
- **Downtown San Diego Partnership** will lead a 2-mile bike ride through Downtown San Diego, stopping at local businesses on Friday, May 1 to kick-off Bike Month.
- **North Park Main Street** will encourage attendees of the SDCCU Festival of Arts on Saturday, May 9 from 11 a.m. – 7 p.m. to GO by BIKE to the event by providing a bike valet station for secure bike storage.
- **San Diego Bicycle Club** will host a bike rodeo and provide free helmets to kids visiting the Barrio Logan Grand Prix on Saturday, May 9.
- **San Diego Community College District Police Department** will share safety information and provide free bike locks to San Diego City, Mesa, and Miramar College students to support Bike to Work Day.
- **San Diego County Bicycle Coalition** will celebrate their fifth annual bike month kick-off with a short community bike ride ending at a Downtown venue with music and food on Thursday, April 30 from 5:30-8 p.m.
- **San Diego County Bicycle Coalition (partnership Bay Park Elem. School)** will host a family-friendly event at De Anza Cove in Mission Bay on Sunday, May 10 from 9 a.m. – 12 p.m., with a bike safety rodeo for kids, bike yoga for parents, short group ride, and more.
- **San Diego County Regional Airport Authority** will promote biking in the San Diego region by installing a bike repair station at the airport and advertising regional bike infrastructure to visitors.
- **San Diego Unified Port District** will guide riders through a 9-mile interactive art bike tour around the San Diego Bay on Sunday, March 29.
- **Scripps Institution of Oceanography (UC San Diego)** will lead a community bike ride on Friday, April 24 from 11 a.m. – 4 p.m. for the UCSD community to encourage residents to bike to work.
